

Learning the CREIGHTON MODEL **FertilityCare™** System begins with a two-hour group introductory session which explains the scientific foundations, methodology, application to various reproductive categories, how to make observations and how to keep a chart. Couples will gain an even deeper understanding at individualized, private follow-up sessions.

After learning to chart according to the CREIGHTON MODEL **FertilityCare™** System, the new women's reproductive health science, NaProTECHNOLOGY, can be applied to correct many health problems experienced by women.

Following the Introductory Session, each couple will have individualized follow-up sessions. These follow-ups with our **FertilityCare™** Practitioner can be scheduled at either our Lowell or Grand Rapids Campuses.

To adequately and confidently learn the system, the recommended follow-up schedule is 2, 4, 6, 8, 12 weeks then 6, 9 and 12 months from the Introductory Session resulting in 8 sessions in a year. If a couple is experiencing difficulty with infertility or with their cycles and charting, additional follow-ups may be recommended. It is highly recommended that couples attend the Introductory Session and Follow-ups together.

Additionally, couples report that the **FertilityCare™** System benefits the relationship by an increase in communication and growth in the following dimensions of their sexuality and within their relationship: Spiritual, Physical, Intellectual, Communicative/Creative and Emotional (SPICE).
