
FLPC Announces New Director

Franciscan Sisters of the Eucharist Receive Second Grant

The Franciscan Sisters of the Eucharist received a second grant from the **Sacred Heart Charitable Foundation** for \$50,000.

Last year's grant of \$50,000 was used to fund "Praise Be to You, Educating for Laudato Si'," a website that provides educational modules that offer hands-on, practical land experiences for various age groups. Grant funds were also used to further the development of the Laudato Si' Sanctuary and the Environmental Education Program at the Lowell campus.

This year's grant will be used to increase awareness of the website and to train people to use the modules. "There is a real need for the principles of *Laudato Si'* to be articulated and put into practice in the education of young people," states Sister Damien Marie Savino, FSE, Ph.D., the director of the project. "We want this website to be of service to parish staff and Catholic educators throughout Michigan and the US." Grant funds will also be used to renovate the yurts on the Lowell Campus for use as potential classroom and rental space.

Prepare/Enrich, a pre-marital assessment tool, is used with couples who are dating or engaged. By using this tool, couples can identify their areas of strengths and areas of potential growth. As a facilitator, I guide



them through the program which helps them to strengthen their bond, increase healthy communication, and learn how to engage in conflict resolution. This program has a great deal of research behind it and aligns with Catholic values. Couples go home with a personalized report and a workbook, not to mention a sense of peace as they move forward toward marriage.
